## Approve Previous Meeting Minutes

## Presidents Update

Valentine's Day grams are on-going, and sales are starting to pick up. We are more organized since the Holiday gram rush.

Apex is on-going. The last update stated we're at $\$ 680$ per move pledged across the school totaling roughly $\$ 24 \mathrm{~K}$. That number does not include flat donations. There have been some cash donations which will go direct into our count. Apex anticipates the trend of last-minute donations to continue. We need to figure out when the donation cutoff is to estimate when we'll get an idea of what we made.

We're hoping this is successful enough to not require more fundraisers for the remainder of the year. We might also look to do this in lieu of Grizzly Challenge next year due to similarity of format. Our timing in the Spring may be a good for future iterations as Fall may conflict with holiday shopping budgets. It also fits well with the classroom tempo of the school right now as we're in the sweet spot between tests.

Big Toy campaign is stopping. We need to turn off that donation option and contact people regarding the disposition of the funds.

The cookbook was largely responsible for $\$ 1400$ in fundraising. We will likely roll this out again this year.
Our Square account is depositing $\sim \$ 9 K$ of funds to our account that are not listed in our Square profile. Square will not talk to Christina since she is not the account holder. Skyler will talk to his neighbor (the account holder) to see about getting it sorted and Christina authorized to act.

## Principle's Report

Apex is going well, and Brian will recommend to continue it next year.
The multi-cultural potluck will occur next on April $28^{\text {th }}$. They need volunteers. There is typically an entertainment, food, and activities component. In the past, Brain has seen the school broken down into wings to theme as regions.

The bond measure is tied to our playground equipment and should replace all equipment. This summer they will re-roof, resurface, and pavements and replace the glass in the exterior windows. Brian will forward that to Christy.
